Format	 An approved QBA RED point congress played under QBA Regulations. Each player must have fewer than 300 Masterpoints as at 30 June 2024. Contestants entering the event are deemed to have agreed to abide by the Regulations and any additional Regulations made by the Tournament Organisers as either posted on the QBA website prior to the start of the event or by appearing on the entry form or by announcement before the start of the event. Each player must have a currently approved ABF system card and is responsible for ensuring the correctness of their classification. Green systems ONLY are permitted. Each pair must have two systemically identical current ABF system cards on the table before the start of play.
Payment	 Pay using MyABF Bridge Credits. Note: One Bridge Credit equals One Dollar (\$1) No payments will be accepted on the day.
Catering	 Sandwich lunch provided. Tea, coffee and biscuits available during morning and afternoon tea. Please BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE.
Wellness Guidelines	Players and officials are asked not to attend any event if they are infectious, or if they are supposed to be isolating or quarantining. Those who come to play and, feeling unwell, self-diagnose that they may be infectious, should inform the director and leave the venue.

WHAT IS A TEAM OF 3?

A Team of 3 is where a captain is assigned to each team as the 4th player. The captain, an experienced player, will partner each of the team members for 2 matches, playing their preferred system.

- QBA Championship event, Red Masterpoints awarded.
- Each player must have fewer than 300 Masterpoints as at 30 June 2024.
- You can enter as a **Team of 3** or as a **pair** or an **individual** to be formed into a Team.
- The QBA organises the team captains and matches a captain with your team but if preferred, teams may arrange for their own captain.
