## **OPEN EVENTS**

- **YELLOW** systems are only allowed in the TBIB Open Teams as per the supplementary regulations.
- **BROWN** sticker conventions and **RED** systems are allowed in all Open and Mixed events.
- All partnerships in every match in the Mixed Teams and Mixed Pairs must consist of one male and one female player.
- All players in the Seniors' Teams must have been born before 1/1/1961.

## **MASTERPOINT LIMITED EVENTS**

Limits as of 1st July 2024 for the masterpoint limited categories in the Spring Nationals

Category	MP limit	Allowed Systems
Novice	100	Green and blue*
Restricted	300	Green and blue*
Under 500	500	Green and blue*
Intermediate	750	Green, blue and red

\* No **brown sticker conventions** are allowed. In addition, a pair may be further restricted from playing any method the CTD judges may not be readily understood by a significant proportion of the players in any of the above fields.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Persons applying to enter the Sydney Spring Nationals should be aware of the following:

- 1. The Regulating Authority (The Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.
- 2. No entry will be regarded as complete unless an entry has been submitted before the closing date, Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2024, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- 3. All players resident in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme.
- 4. Players born on or after 1/1/1999 receive a 50% rebate on their entry fees to all events.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as announced by the Director and posted on the noticeboard.
- Mobile phones and other means of electronic communication must be switched off whilst in the playing area. Penalties will apply for non-compliance (see ABF Tournament Regulations, Section 21).

- 7. Players reaching the semi-finals or finals of the Open, Women's, Mixed, Seniors' or Intermediate Teams must lodge their mobile phones (and other electronic communication devices) with the Tournament Director (or the Tournament Organiser) who will secure them during each session.
- 8. Systems permitted in the various events are determined in accordance with the ABF Tournament Regulations.


## **PARKING & PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

a Free parking onsite

A Canterbury Railway Station is about a 15 minute walk (1 km) from the venue.

The 413 and 491 bus routes stop at the racecourse. Check <u>Transport NSW</u> for the latest public transportation details.

The 413 bus runs from Central Station (Railway Square, Stand J) via Lewisham Station to Campsie Station. Journey takes around 45 min from Central, including a 4-minute walk from bus stop at Roslyn St.



# The 491 bus runs between Hurstville, **Canterbury** and Ashfield Railway Stations.

Alternative transportation is to book an UBER or a TAXI.

## ACCOMMODATION



We have negotiated a deal with the Comfort Inn & Suites at Burwood. It is approx. 4 km from the venue. A courtesy bus is available to take you the venue in the morning and there's a return trip after play at the end of the day.

At the time of booking there will be a non-refundable 25% deposit over the phone. There is a 48-hour cancellation policy. When you book mention that you are playing bridge at the Congress at Canterbury Racecourse.
