

### **1.** Restricted and Novice Players

- The first week (6 to 12 July) of events starting with the Welcome Pairs followed by the Central West Festival is perfect for you. Just like being at the Club. Prizes every day with a major Prize at the end of the Orange Teams Day.
- While you're playing you will be alongside the best players in the Country battling out in the Interstate Teams.
- Stretch your skills and play in the Restricted Butler 13 and 14 July.
- Give one or two of the Swiss Pairs A or B a go in week 2. Much tougher but you will improve.
- 2. Advanced and above with 5 to 7 Days available
- Get a team together for the Orange Congress Teams as a warmup for the Butler Pairs on 13 and 14 July. If you make Stage 2 congratulations. If not play in Swiss Pars A on 15 and 16 July and if you just can't help yourself stay on for Swiss Pairs B on 17 and 18 July.
- If you are a mixed pair and don't make Stage 2 of the Open sign up for the Mixed Butler Stage 1 on 15 and 16 July.

### 3. Intermediate Players

- The entire first week is great for Intermediate players and the Swiss Pairs A and B in Week 2, while they are not called Intermediate the Butler Stage 2 and Mixed Butler take most of the Advanced + players out of the Swiss Events in that week.





Visit **parks** around town, particularly beautiful **Cook Park** in Summer Street between Clinton and Samson Streets. **Elephant Park** and adjoining **Moulder Park** are large enough to walk through for exercise and pleasure.

Visit the **Orange Botanic Gardens ?** 300 Hill Street and have a coffee at the **Eat Botanic Cafe.** Cycle or drive to **Gosling Creek Reserve** which is not far past the Orange Health Service (Hospital) at 28 Forest Road. Shared paths suitable for roller blading, walking and cycling, there are picnic/barbecue areas, children's play equipment and even fishing in the reservoir.

Extinct volcano **Mount Canobolas** *Gaanha Bula* is 1390 m above sea level so head to the summit for wonderful views of Orange and surrounding area. If you are thinking of walking one of the trails in this area make sure you plan ahead and are aware that the steep and possible icy tracks might be very slippery.

Enjoy the early morning **Bird Walk** lead by Neil Morrow at 8.00 am on Sunday July 14, Meet inside the botanic gardens near the function centre building. No bookings needed, just turn up. You'll need to wear warm clothes, sturdy shoes, and take binoculars and a walking stick if you need one. No cost but a donation to Friends of the Botanic Gardens would be welcome. Have a coffee afterwards at nearby Eat Botanic. Bird watching is available at any time at the **Ploughman's Wetlands** in Ploughman's Lane and at the **Gosling Creek Reserve.**



### **Procedure for 2024 Central West Festival of Bridge Prize**

The 2024 Central West Festival of Bridge Prize has been established to entice bridge players to come to Orange during the first week of the Australian National Championships and play in the Central West Festival of Bridge events.

Central West Festival of Bridge (CWF) Events include:

- Orange City Council Welcome Pairs (6<sup>th</sup> July 2024)
- Mudgee Bridge Club Central West Festival Swiss Pairs (7th July 2024)
- Dubbo Bridge Club Central West Festival Swiss Pairs (8th July 2024)
- Bathurst Bridge Club Central West Festival Swiss Pairs (9th July 2024)
- Cowra Bridge Club Central West Festival Matchpoint Pairs (10th July 2024)
- Parkes Bridge Club Central West Festival Matchpoint Pairs (10th July 2024)
- Orange Bridge Club 2024 Annual Congress and Central West Festival Pairs (11<sup>th</sup> July 2024)
- Orange Bridge Club 2024 Annual Congress and Central West Festival Teams (12<sup>th</sup> July 2024).

These events are for players of all ability level and offer prizes at Open, Restricted (under 300 MP) and Novice (under 100 MP) levels.

Only players participating in CWF events held at the Orange Ex-Services Club are eligible to enter the draw for the Central West Festival Prizes Draw.

Players in the Orange City Council Welcome Pairs will receive 4 entries per player. For players in the Mudgee, Dubbo, Bathurst, Orange Pairs and Orange Teams there will be 2 entries per player per day (full day sessions). For Parkes and Cowra pairs sessions there will be one entry per player (half day sessions).

### **Bonus Entries:**

During April, May and June we have asked the Bathurst, Cowra, Dubbo, Mudgee, Orange and Parkes Bridge Clubs to designate one red point event at their club in each of these months as a Central West Festival of Bridge event. This will allow players to qualify for bonus entries in the Central West Festival Prize. When the third club event has been completed in June each participating club will send to <u>secretary@orangebridgeclub.com</u> the dates of each designated event and the names of players who competed in each event. Players are eligible to receive a bonus entry for each qualifying event played at their local club, provided they attend and play in at least one Central West Festival events held in Orange (6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> July). By way of an example, if a player plays all 3 designated events at their home club plus all the CWF events in Orange they will accumulate 19 entries in the draw. The more games played the greater the chance of winning a prize. However, a player competing in any or all designated club event who does not attend any CWF event held in Orange will not receive an entry in the CWF prize draw.

A player is eligible to win only one prize.

### The following procedure then applies:

- Entries in the prize draw will be uniquely numbered, with the players name and qualifying session listed against each number on a spreadsheet.
- If a player at a Central West Festival event at the Orange Ex Services Club in July is eligible for bonus entries, these will be added according to the number of CWF designated sessions in which the player took part at their home club. This could be one, two or three additional entries.
- The spreadsheet of entries (updated daily) will be placed on the notice board adjacent to the registration desk for inspection.
- At the Central West Festival celebrations to be held at the Orange Ex-Service Club on Friday evening (12<sup>th</sup> July 2024), five prizes will be drawn using a random number generator.
- The prizes are
  - First \$1500,
  - Second \$500,
  - Third Dozen Bottles of Phillip Shaw Wines,
  - Fourth Indulgence Experience at Swinging Bridge Winery,
  - Fifth Dinner for Two at Birdie Noshery and Drinking Est.
